EdenRidge and the Log College & Seminary are pleased to announce the EdenRidge Resource Center project, which will house the Chad Brand Theological Library—a remarkable collection of 25,000 theological books. This unique library will serve pastors, missionaries, Christian workers, and theological students, providing a quiet and enriching space for study, reflection, and renewal.

The lower level will feature the library, while the main floor will include a boardroom, reading lounges, and welcoming common areas for all guests.

The total cost of the project is \$1,500,000. The books, valued at \$500,000, have already been donated. The 3,000-square-foot Resource Center building is expected to cost \$800,000, with an additional \$200,000 designated for paving the road to the facility.


We believe this project will be a game-changer, advancing our mission to care for those who serve Christ around the world.

Fundraising Milestones

The key financial milestones for completing the proposed 3,000 square foot EdenRidge Resource Center and Chad Brand Theological Library are outlined below. The total estimated project cost is \$1,500,000. This phased approach allows us to move forward with construction debt-free as funding becomes available, providing both flexibility and steady progress.



Phase 1 Books Acquisition - \$500,000

This phase is already fully funded, as the 25,000 theological books have been donated and are currently stored in a climate-controlled facility. The conservative estimated value of the books is \$500,000.

Phase 2 Dry-in Construction - \$400,000

Site Work and Design - Estimated Cost: \$25,000

Includes grading, basic excavation, utility access, parking, and architectural and engineering design.

Dry-In Phase - Estimated Cost: \$375,000

Foundation, framing, roof, windows, exterior doors, and siding to create a fully enclosed, weather-tight shell.

Funds needed for Phase 1

Pre-launch campaign - one lead gift or multiple gifts totaling \$400,000

Phase 3 Library Occupancy - \$200,000

Finish Lower Level (Library Space) - Estimated Cost: \$75,000 Insulation, drywall, HVAC, lighting, flooring, and other interior components for the lower-level library.

Fire Suppression System - Estimated Cost: \$40,000 Installation of dry code-compliant fire suppression for the lower level (library).

Furnish Lower Level - Estimated Cost: \$85,000 Bookshelves and related furnishings.

Funds needed for Phase 2

- 20 churches or donors pledging \$5,000
- 20 churches or donors pledging \$2,500
- 50 churches or donors pledging \$1,000

Phase 4 Main Level Occupancy - \$200,000

Finish Main Level (Boardroom and Reading Lounges) - Estimated Cost: \$150,000 Interior buildout including walls, HVAC extension, electrical, flooring, trim, technology infrastructure, and three bathrooms (including one ADA-compliant).

Furnish Main Level - Estimated Cost: \$50,000 Boardroom table and chairs, reading lounge furniture, and related equipment.

Funds needed for Phase 3

- One lead gift or multiple major gifts totaling \$100,000
- 10 churches or donors pledging \$5,000
- 50 churches or donors pledging \$1,000

Phase 5 Paving - \$200,000

Pave Access Road - Estimated Cost: \$200,000


Paving the access road from the EdenRidge entrance leading to the new building site, including grading, base prep, and asphalt.

- 100 donors pledging \$1,000
